**Task 3:** Click "Crash Course # 12: How We Got Here: Society and Societal Change." These short, 8 to 12-minute videos are a great way to familiarize yourself with some of the concepts we use in sociology. You'll miss Nicole...SAY IT!

**Task 4:** Each lecture will be accompanied by an article which will correspond to that lecture's theme. This week will require you to upload a "journal response" to the article. Remember, one *full* page for the full 10 out of 10 points credit and make sure to analyze, not summarize (don't tell me what the article is *about* (summarizing), tell me what you *think* about it (analysis)).
