Instructions for the Week of October 5 to 9

Task 3: Click "Crash Course Sociology #17." These short, 8 to 12-minute videos are a great way to familiarize yourself with some of the concepts we use in sociology. Nicole Sweeny will now take over!

Task 4: Each lecture will be accompanied by an article which will correspond to that lecture's theme. For this lecture you need only to read the article; no journal response on the Google Classroom Page is needed this week.

Task 5: Click "Video: A Class Divided" and watch the second 40 minutes of the documentary on the Youtube link. The videos are approximately one to two hours for each lecture. They can be watched at your convenience but do try to absorb the entire film. After watching the film, you will go to our Google Classroom page and upload to the Discussion Board Response. On this page I would like you to write a short, one-paragraph comment about the film. After that, please respond to two other student's responses. Please keep your responses to other students respectful – we don't need to agree, but let's be polite and mature in how we talk with each other.
