4. What is a fair immigration policy? Does the United States allow too many immigrants to come in? Too few? Are we stronger or weaker as a result of our immigration policies?
5. Lipset's article was written pre-9/11. If Lipset was writing today do you believe he would credit 9/11 (and the U.S. response) with the drastic reversal of his thesis in 2000 in the last decade?
6. What are the various aspects of American Exceptionalism proposed by Jouet and do you agree with the author that it is these aspects that are hastening our decline?
7. Does our own government predict our decline? What is the conclusion by analyst Dave Lindorff? What do you think of the various 'scenarios' the U.S. government see for the future?
8. Author Reihan Salam sees "...polyethnic hierarchy [as] the norm throughout modern history, not national unity or egalitarian pluralism." If true, what implications does that have for the United States?
